



**LINCONE FEDERAL CREDIT UNION  
ELECTION 2019**

Dear Member:

The nominating committee of the LINCONE Federal Credit Union, comprised of three members selected by the Chairman of the Board of Directors, has nominated candidates for three (3), three (3) year term, Board vacancies that will occur in April of 2019. Names and short profiles of the nominees appear on the reverse side of this notice.

Eligible members seeking office, but not nominated by the nominating committee, may be nominated by petition with signatures of at least 180 members of the LINCONE Federal Credit Union. Nomination forms are available from Nominating Committee members or at the Credit Union office. Petitions include a request for personal information about the nominees, similar to that of the nominees listed on the reverse side.

**NOMINATION PETITIONS MUST BE RETURNED TO A NOMINATING COMMITTEE MEMBER OR THE CREDIT UNION OFFICE NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 15, 2019.**

If nominations from the nominating committee and the petitions are equal to the number of vacancies, an election will **not** be held and the nominees will be officially inducted into office at the Credit Union's Annual Meeting on April 11, 2019.

If the number of nominations exceeds the number of vacancies, an election will be held. Ballot boxes will be available for member voting as shown in the schedule below.

To be eligible to vote, you must be 18 years of age and a member in good standing of LINCONE Federal Credit Union as of February 28, 2019.
